COLOUR

Very deep black in colour.

AROMA

An interesting bouquet that displays a gentle perfume of aniseed, roasted nuts, lavender, mineral, earth, tar and espresso.

PALATE

A big, even and persistent coating entry of pure fruit weight. Rounded purple to black fruits that continue on an extended and long finish, with a wealth of classy tannins that make the finish very soft, rounded and balanced.

WINEMAKING

Machine picked fruit. Fruit was crushed and de-stemmed into open top fermenters. Time on skins varied from 9 days to 21 days. At pressing, all free run and pressings are combined in tank and matured together.

MATURATION

The wine was matured in new and old French and American oak for 24 months and then bottled with minimal fining and without filtration.

ANALYSIS

Alc 16.5%, ph 3.3, Acidity 7.5

CELLAR POTENTIAL

This wine has such great balance that it will age effortlessly for 15+ years
