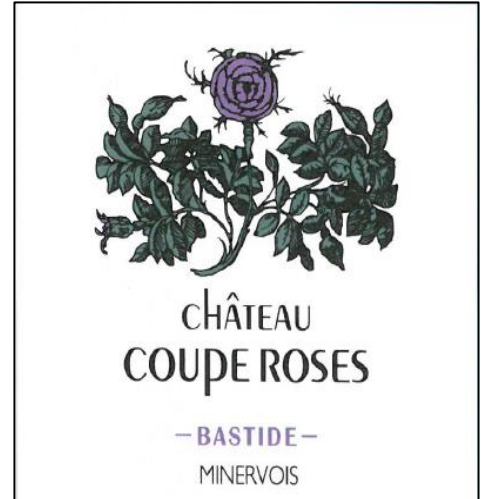
Minervois red wine Appellation

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION:

Mountain area in High Minervois with South/South-West exposed plots and an Altitude of between 200-350 meters

GRAPE VARIETY: 50% Carignan
50% Grenache with a little Syrah

TERROIR: Rocky hillsides
Clay-limestone
10-50 year-old vines
Yield of 40hl/ha



AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES: Organic farming
Ground cover practices
Compost spreading

VINIFICATION: Manual harvesting
Traditional maceration up to 20-30 days

AGEING: Stainless steel vat

WINE TASTING: Pale red colour, brilliant which shines with light shades of purple. The scent reminds you of its fruitiness and the Carignan from where this wine comes, it is also in the mouth where the fresh red fruits dominate, associated with a refreshing liveliness. A perfect wine for all occasions, aperitifs or meals
